In the spirit of connecting more of our members and expanding our Match Play event, we will host up to 64 Men and 32 Ladies. Players will be seeded by handicap and put into pods of 4. You will play 3 matches to determine a winner of your Pod and set the bracket of 16 Men and 8 women who will carry on a bracketed Match Play tournament to be completed by mid August. Event will include lunch both days, dinner on Sunday following play and breakfast Monday prior to golf. All handicaps welcome, let's fill the event and have a great time!

#### Entry Fee \$300

Round Robin play Sunday, June 30- Monday, July 1 Final Bracket Match to be completed by September 15<sup>th</sup>. (Approx. 3 weeks per round to complete bracketed matches.)

#### **Format**

18-Hole NET Match Play. 100 % of Course Handicap applied.
\* Players will be seeded into Group Play based on handicap index. Each pod will have 4 players who will play a round against each of the other 3 in their respective group. 1 point for a win, ½ point for a tie and 0 points for a loss. The player with the most points will move on as the Group Winner into the bracketed tournament finals. If two players tie in Group points, the total number of holes won will break the tie. Round Robin Group play will form final brackets

Golf Shop credit paid out to all who make it out of group play based on final results.

Participants must hold current USGA handicaps, and post all scores according to the handicap guidelines.
